A message from the Chair of the Board and the Executive Director

We came together to overcome many challenges last year.

First, we came together like never before when the COVID-19 pandemic was declared a few weeks before the start of our 2020 to 2021 fiscal year. To help protect families against the virus, team members from all areas came forward to move all but two families from our downtown communal shelter to apartments in the community.

During the following 12 months, we supported 80 families and 165 children in our pandemic shelter operations — and 96 per cent of the families surveyed said they felt safe. In fact, Inn from the Cold had no COVID-19 positive cases among families in our shelter program. Equally important, despite our capacity being down to 12 from 20 due to restrictions, we turned away no family in need. This achievement was supported by the evolution of our homeless prevention and diversion program, which helped more families stay housed and away from a shelter.

Besides providing a roof over families' heads, various teams also came together to realize our mission and demonstrate our values in creative, caring, and compassionate ways. They redesigned our operating model, twice, and implemented those changes while honoring trauma-informed and housing-first principles. They launched responsive programs to ensure vulnerable children and youth didn't fall through the cracks, with heightened advocacy support with schools and volunteer-delivered online homework assistance. They introduced tools and activities to support each other's personal health and wellness, and they developed videos to strengthen connections and wellbeing within families. They pursued innovative ways to engage community supporters, successfully raising 64 per cent of our operational needs from our incredible fellow Calgarians. And to guide our future direction, the board developed our strategic plan for the next three years.

And we could go on. The experience of the pandemic has differed for each of us — whether we're community partners, community supporters, board members, volunteers, employees, or families in need. Similarly, our stories are different, reflecting the diversity in who we are as people and what we strive to be as an organization and as a larger community.

Hope. Connection. Resilience. It's been all possible because **we came together**. Our future looks bright, as we prepare for Inn from the Cold's new home by the fall of 2022.

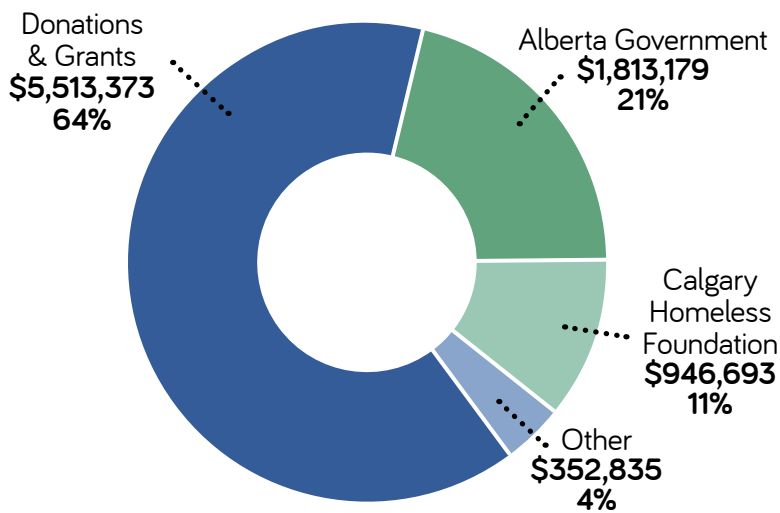

About Inn from the Cold

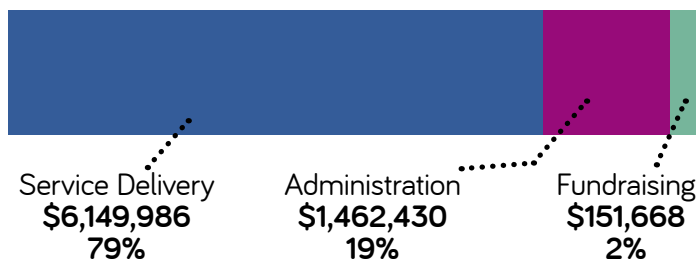

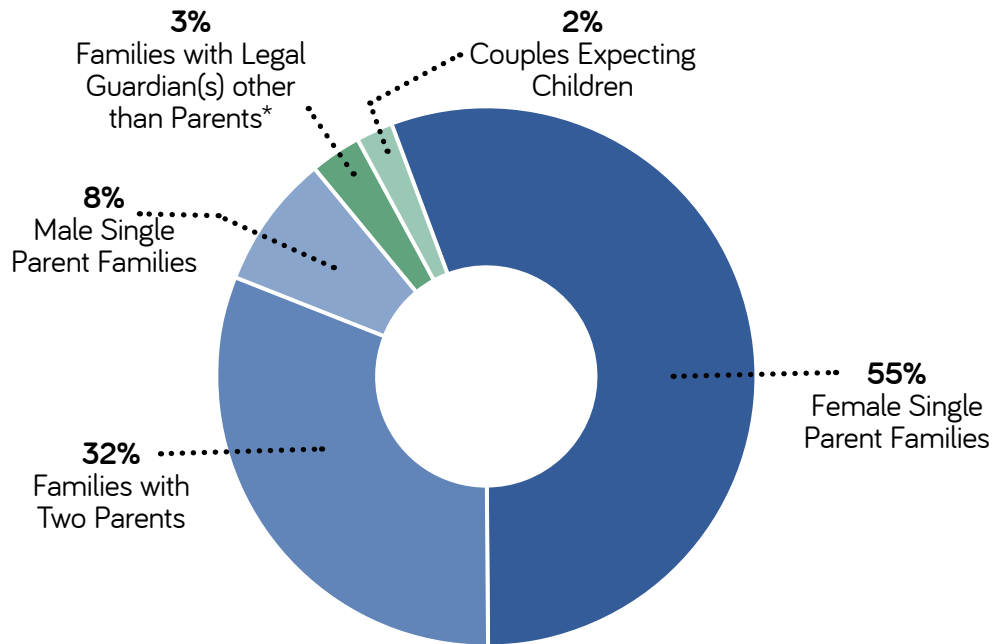

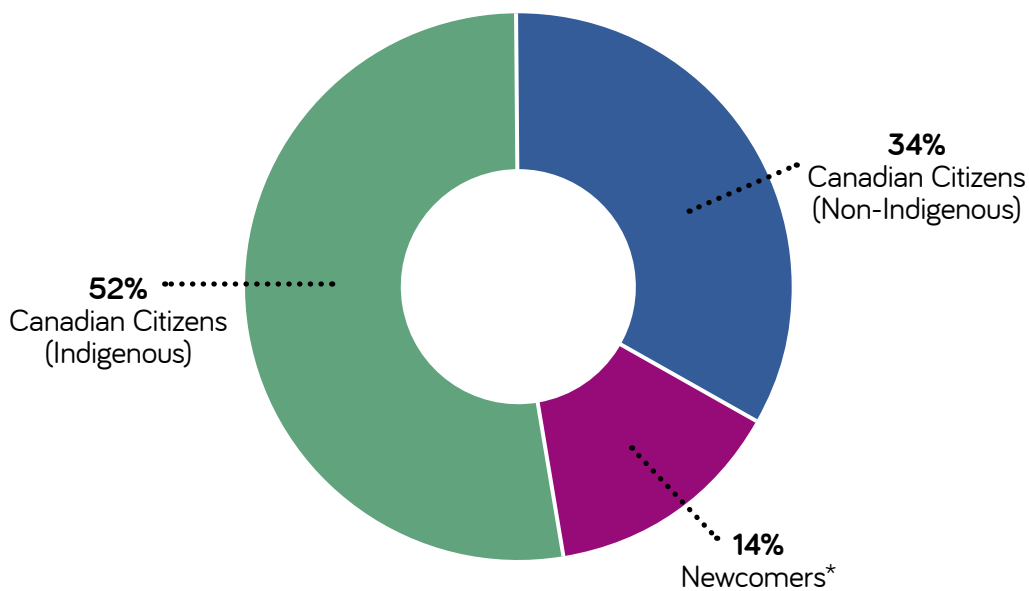


**The types of families supported
from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021**



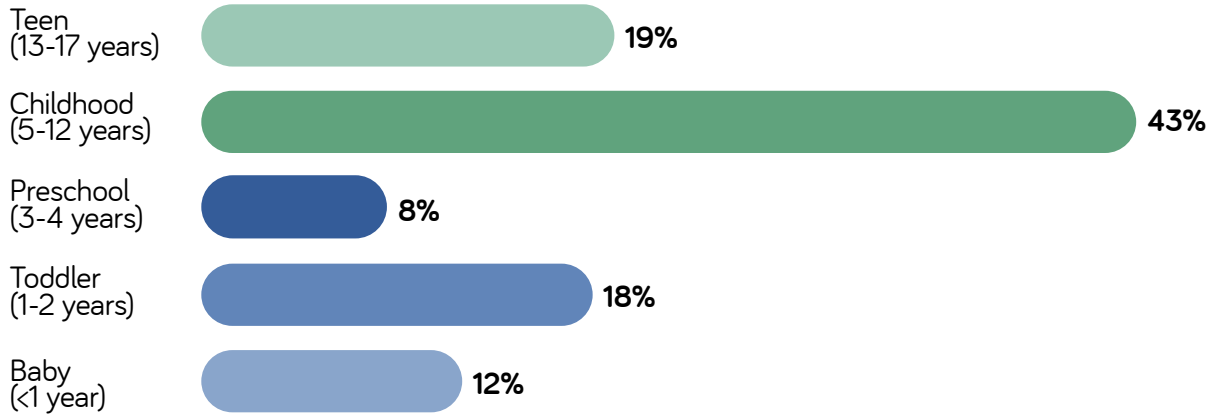

from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021**

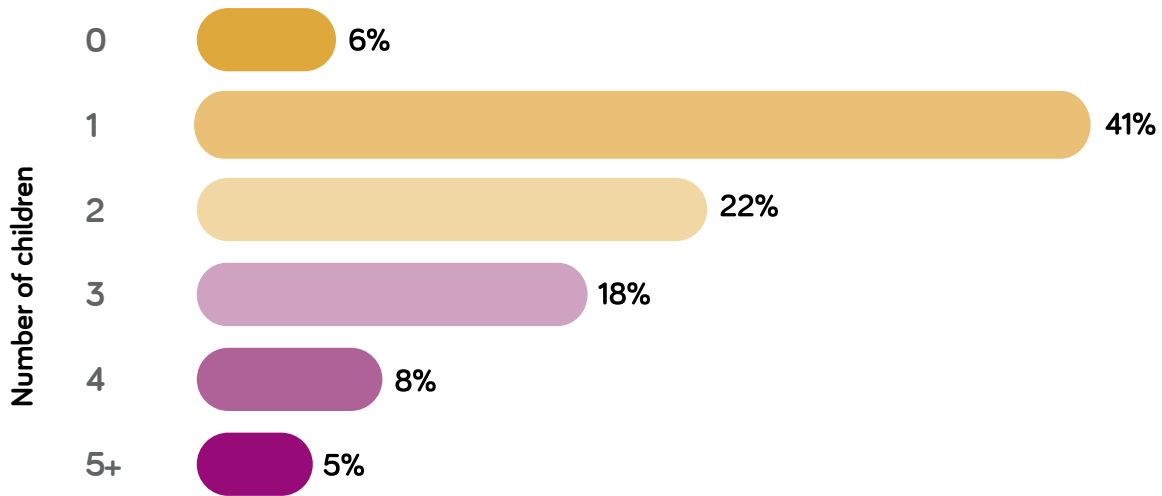

About child, youth and family homelessness

Inn from the Cold focuses on the wellness of children, youth, and families to break the cycle of homelessness. Trauma caused by family poverty, conflict, breakdown and abuse are not only contributing factors to child and youth homelessness — but also childhood homelessness itself has been linked as a pathway to chronic and multi-generational homelessness. For these reasons, supporting the mental, social, and physical wellbeing of families and their children is a priority at Inn from the Cold.

About what leads to family homelessness

The causes of family homelessness are varied and complex. Circumstances that can contribute to family homelessness include unexpected major expenses, sudden injury, serious illness, family violence or breakdown, relationship difficulties, untreated trauma, underemployment, financial losses, and addictions. Indigenous and visible minority families experience significant systematic barriers, including racial and cultural discrimination that heighten their risk of experiencing homelessness. In light of this, Inn from the Cold strives to apply a culturally diverse lens and Indigenous worldview to the services we provide.



Homeless prevention and diversion program

This program **helps families to either stay in their existing home or to locate available permanent housing as quickly as possible.** The delivery of the service is customized according to a family's unique circumstances and needs. It may include short-term financial support, landlord mediation, locating new permanent housing as needed, providing temporary emergency shelter if necessary, case management, and coordinated support from local social services and community partners. The most common reasons for inquiry include financial difficulties, relationship problems, and an existing housing situation that's unsuitable, unsafe, or unstable in some way.

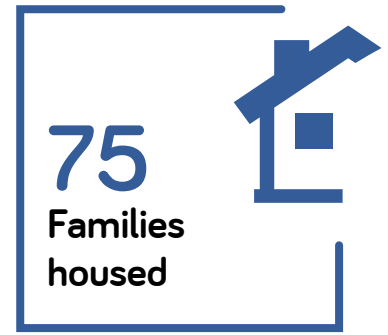
Emergency shelter program

This program provides **temporary emergency shelter to families** when they're unable to stay in their existing homes and there's no suitable housing available in the community. Besides providing a safe roof over their heads, the program also covers other basic needs for families, such as food, clothing, footwear, toiletries, baby items, and special supplies for child and youth. These supplies can include sports and recreational equipment such as bikes and special items for school and for birthday and holiday celebrations.

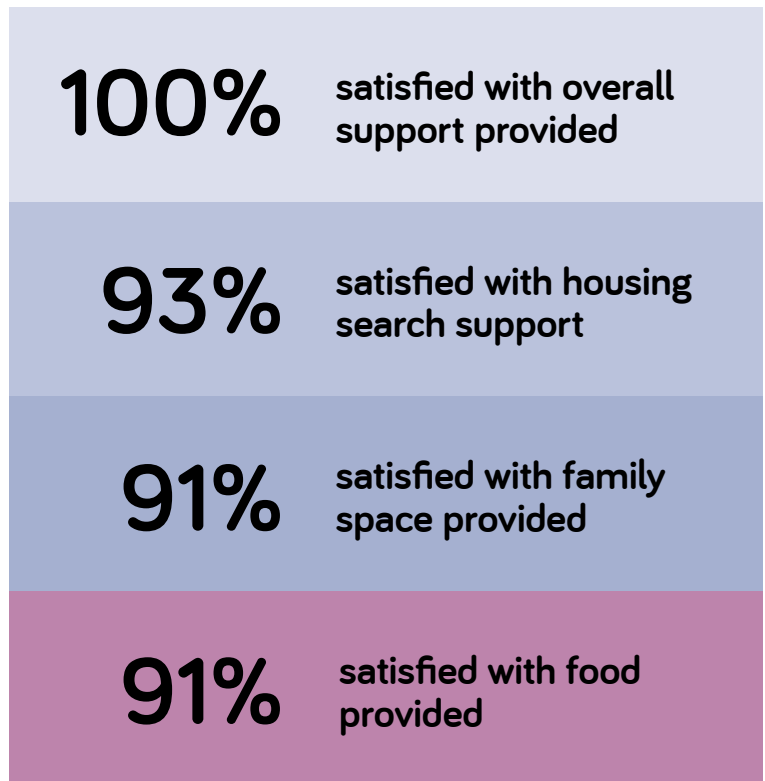

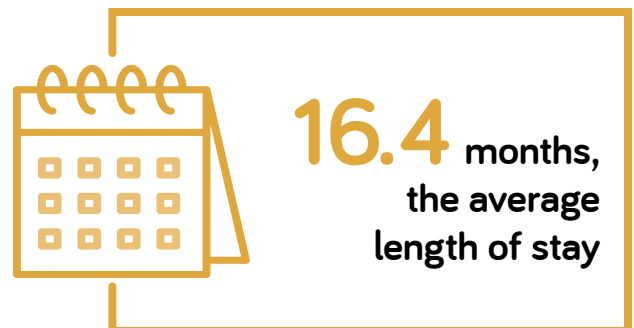
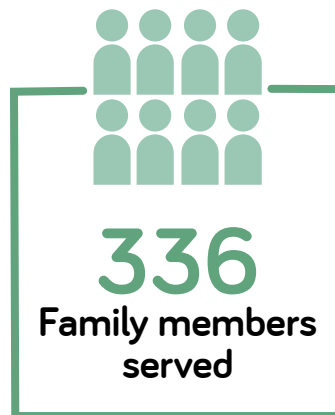

Housing program

This program includes **case management, housing, financial help** with damage deposits and rent if needed, **and coordinated supports**. Case management includes goal setting, relationship and community connection building, advocacy, and assistance with various government and community supports. The housing options provide for a range of needs by families, from maximum support with transitional housing to minimal to no support with independent housing. For coordinated supports, IFTC family support workers and case managers work with community partners to provide the additional supports each family needs. Those additional supports may include services to address family wellness, physical health, mental health, and life autonomy.

Volunteer resources and recognition

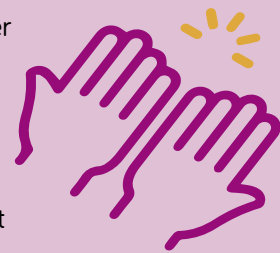
Volunteers play a crucial role in Inn from the Cold's ability to serve families. They serve in a variety of positions that support the operation of IFTC family programs, many of which became virtual or were otherwise reimagined to keep volunteers and families healthy and safe during the COVID-19 pandemic. Main volunteer programs included the department's video series on YouTube on a range of how-to topics and recreational activities. Other initiatives included translator services, the virtual homework helper program, and the birthday-in-a-box kits that were delivered to children whose families were in one of our family programs.
